Ella May Whitney Award Selection Process

Ella May Whitney graduated in 1891. In 1931 she provided the financial support to establish the Ella May Whitney Prize. That funding has since run out and the Foundation has stepped in to provide the funds for the award. Each year, the members of the graduating class select one member of the class who best exemplifies the ideals of Ella May Whitney.

These include scholarship, social aptitude, personality, leadership, executive ability, growth, loyalty, integrity and above all else, participation in school activities. The award is announced at Commencement. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required for consideration. Nominations: A call for nominations goes out to students, faculty and staff beginning during February and will be due back March 3rd, 2017. To be nominated, the nominator must fill out a nomination form detailing why they think the individual being nominated meets the criteria listed above and should be considered for the award.

Selection: A committee of administrators and faculty meet to review each of the nominations and to select the award winner based on the criteria and the quality of the nominations. The committee should have representatives from Athletics, Student Activities, Multicultural Affairs, Residence Life as well as other interested faculty and staff.
